When telling a story, native and near-native signers use certain ASL features in creative ways to make the story "come alive." Strategies such as constructed dialogue, use of classifiers, mime, gestures and facial expression are layered into the expressive narrative.

Developing the ability to incorporate these strategies will increase a signer's accuracy, effectiveness and naturalness in delivering a message.
